Steeped in history, The Keppel's Head hotel honors Admiral Augustus Keppel (1725-1786). Built in 1779 after a fire, it was named for this popular naval hero who commanded during the War of the Austrian Succession and the Seven Years' War. Keppel's fame likely influenced the choice, as inns often used well-known figures on their signs. The Keppel's Head has a longstanding connection to the sea. Throughout its existence, it's been a favorite amongst sailors. Notably, after another fire in 1803, naval officers and midshipmen even funded its reconstruction. Today, the tradition continues. The hotel offers a welcoming space for both guests and visitors, featuring the Captain's Table restaurant with lunch and dinner menus.
